1. Enemy Activity.

A. BRITISH WVE reported A/C Hercules A/c attack at 231518 consisted of 8 bombs - 7 missed and 1 ricocheted from foredeck into sea failing to explode.

B. 1 Mirage, 1 A4 attacked AOA 231535. A4 splashed by rapier then the Mirage turned away. No damage to AOA.

2. Own Activity. Update reference paras 3/4:

Total attacks by each of 2 SHAR on 29 May against Stanley were 3 and against People Is 2.

3. A/C Accident. Slippery deck in INVINCIBLE led to SHAR rolling forward over ship's side while ship manoeuvring to launch. A/C lost but pilot ejected and recovered.

4. Red Cross. UGANDA anchored Grantham Sound for UK and ARG CASEVAC. HERALD joining UGANDA am 30th to collect WOs and transfer medical stores.
