1. WE SEE NUMEROUS MAJOR DIFFICULTIES IN DORR'S DRAFT RESOLUTION:

(A) THE PROVISIONS FOR THE EARLY COMMENCEMENT AND EARLY COMPLETION OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PARAGRAPH 3 OF SCR 502 ARE UNACCEPTABLE. WE COULD NOT ACCEPT 'FULLY AND WITHOUT DELAY' IN PARAGRAPH 1. NOR COULD WE ACCEPT PARAGRAPH 2(III), DESPITE THE

LEEWAY GIVEN BY THE PHRASE 'WITH A VIEW':

(B) THE FINAL PHRASE OF PARAGRAPH 2(I) IS UNACCEPTABLE AS WE HAVE ALWAYS CONTENDED THAT PARAGRAPH 1 OF SCR 502 WAS ADDRESSED TO ARGENTINA AND WAS NOT RELEVANT TO THE MEASURES WE HAVE TAKEN IN SELF-DEFENCE:

(C) THERE IS NO DEADLINE FOR THE COMMENCEMENT OF ARGENTINE WITHDRAWAL OR FOR ITS COMPLETION OR FOR THE CEASEFIRE:

(D) THE REFERENCE IN PARAGRAPH 3 TO PARAGRAPHS 2 AND 4 OF SCR 505 REINTRODUCES THE 'APPROACH' FOLLOWED BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL IN HIS FIRST ROUND OF NEGOTIATIONS:

(E) THE REFERENCE TO PARAGRAPH 4 OF THE SAME RESOLUTION GIVES HIM A ROLE IN NEGOTIATING 'TERMS' FOR A CEASEFIRE, WHEREAS WE WISH TO LEAVE THE ARRANGEMENT OF THE CEASEFIRE TO THE COMMANDERS.

(F) OPERATIVE PARAGRAPH 4 IS, AS YOU HAVE SAID, WHOLLY UNACCEPTABLE.
