7. Force Troops.

a. 40 Cdo RM. Defence of the FMA remains the primary task. Ten enemy were captured at NEW HOUSE (GR 7798), they were in a poor condition and assessed to be the remnants of a Coy at SAN CARLOS on D Day. The arrival of 2 re-equipped Coys of 1 WG is awaited.

8. Logistics.

a. Build up of combat supplies in forward areas continues. Three new LCU loads moved forward in HMS INTREPID to FITZROY on the night 11/12 Jun. SIR GERAINT moved to TEAL overnight to consolidate 3-Cdo Bde echelons.

b. The offloading of ammunition from SIR TRISTRAM continues.

9. Casualties. Some casualties were sustained during the attack on 12 Jun, however, the extent of them is not yet known.

10. Future Intentions. The remaining phases of the attack to secure the liberation of PORT STANLEY will be undertaken by stages.

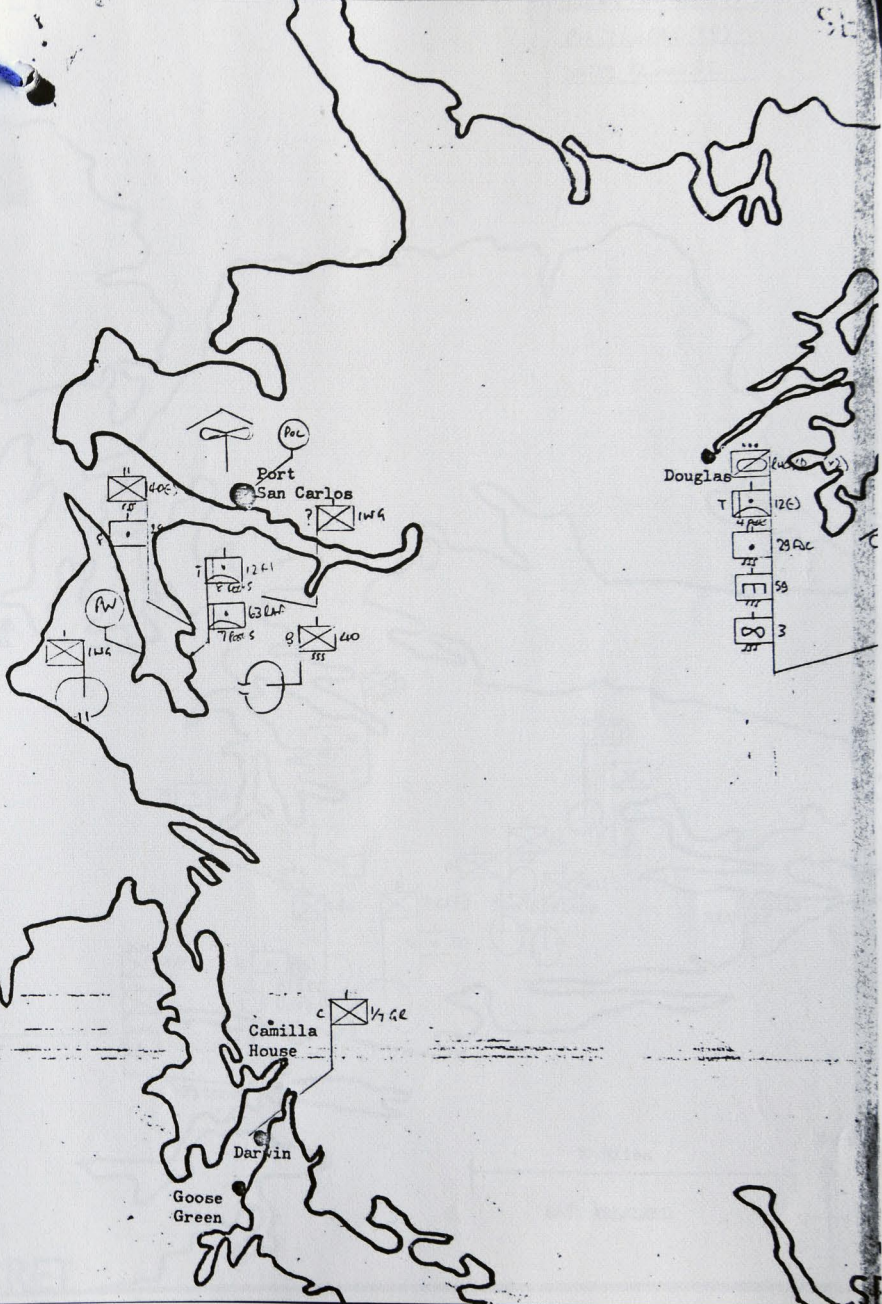
A. Land Forces Deployment Map

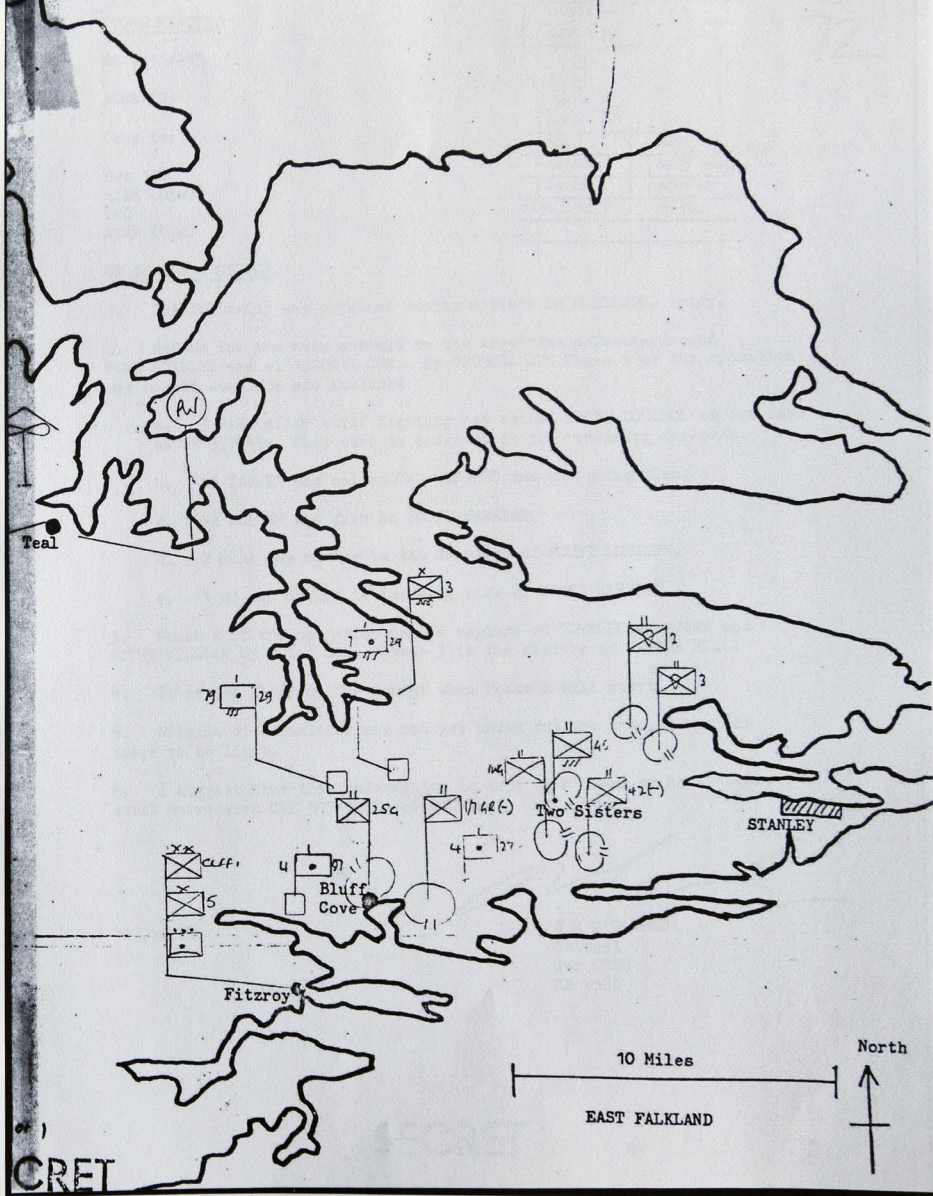
