The late Wright Case.

Lord Rothschild spoke to Nigel Wicks on the telephone at 1710 on Wednesday 3 December. Lord Rothschild asked that Mr Wicks take a record of what he was saying and then said:-

"I have never had any discussions re security or intelligence matters with the Prime Minister in my flat or anywhere else."

Mr Wicks said it was difficult to speak on the 'phone, but asked if Lord Rothschild was absolutely sure about the words "or anywhere else".

Lord Rothschild said emphatically "Yes, with the Prime Minister". Mr Wicks asked him if he remembered anything else but Lord Rothschild said he did not know what Mr Wicks was talking about, he had had no discussions with the Prime Minister.
