When the Prime Minister spoke to Chancellor Kohl on the telephone this evening, it was agreed that Kohl would send over Teltchik to brief her on his visit to Moscow. The Prime Minister welcomed this.

Teltchik intends to come over on Monday 7 November. He can spend 90 per cent of his time with me but I think we will have, somehow, to find twenty minutes when he can see the Prime Minister. Could you try to chisel something out of the diary that day - preferably not too early or too late, since he has got to come over from Bonn and get back there?

Also a dreadful warning: the Prime Minister proposed to Chancellor Kohl that she might go over to Germany to see him one weekend, ideally before the European Council. Chancellor Kohl responded enthusiastically. I am glad to say that no date was set but this is lying in wait for us.
